

TOILET REBATE PROGRAM

Kearns Improvement District (KID) is offering rebates of up to \$125 for residential customers who replace their high water using toilets with EPA [WaterSense](#) High Efficiency Toilet (HET) models. The program is part of our water conservation program designed to help us reach our goal to reduce per capita water use by 25% by the year 2025.

Toilets eligible for rebate **must** be HET's (which use an average of 1.28 gallons per flush) and **must** be on the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) [WaterSense](#) list which can be found at www.epa.gov/watersense/pubs/het.htm. Another way to identify the toilet is to look for the [WaterSense](#) logo. Toilets may be purchased at any supplier.



ELIGIBILITY

Customers must meet the following and any additional requirements listed on the application to be eligible:

- Be a residential customer of KID.
- The installation address must be in the service area of KID.
- Must live in a single-family home built before 1994.
- Toilet must be installed within 30 days of purchase.
- If you have received a toilet from KID in the past, you will not be eligible.
- Application must be approved by KID staff.
- New toilet is for the replacement of existing high-water using toilets only.
- Deadline for this program is October 31, 2010. All toilets must be purchased and installation verified before the deadline date to receive the rebate.

INSTALLATION

Homeowners may install the toilets themselves, or they may hire a plumber or contractor to do the job. Owners are responsible for proper installation and associated costs. Installation may be subject to verification by water utility personnel.

REBATE

- Rebate is in the form of a credit to customer's account.
- Rebate credits of up to \$125 will be put on customer's account after applications are received and verification of installation is complete.
- Rebates will be given on a first-come, first-serve basis until we reach our goal of 300 toilets or October 31, 2010.
- Only one rebate per household.
- Please allow up to 30 days for the rebate.

DISPOSAL OF OLD TOILETS

Replaced toilets should be disposed of properly.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply for the rebate, you must fill out the application (located below) and provide the original, dated sales receipt for the toilet (keep a photocopy of your receipt.) These items must be mailed or dropped off at the following address:

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Please review the following program guidelines and other important information:

- Must be a residential customer of Kearns Improvement District (KID)
- Toilets purchased by homeowners for this program are for their own personal use in the homeowner's private residence located in KID's service area.
- High Efficiency Toilets, (HET's), homeowners purchase shall replace only high-water using toilets which predate 1994. Toilets installed as part of new construction or bathroom additions do not qualify for this program.
- Toilet must be installed within 30 days of homeowner's date of purchase.
- If you have received a toilet in the past from Kearns Improvement District, you will not be eligible.
- Application must be approved by KID staff.
- Rebate is in the form of a credit to customer's account up to \$125.00.
- Rebates are on first come, first serve basis until 300 rebates are issued or October 31, 2010.
- Only one rebate per household.
- Allow up to 30 days for the rebate.
- Kearns Improvement District makes no representation or warranty that the homeowner will be satisfied with the performance of the HET.
- Kearns Improvement District assumes no liability for any loss, damage or expense in connection with the materials, workmanship or fitness of the HET; or the installation of the HET; or with the use of the HET.
- Homeowner hereby releases and agrees to hold harmless Kearns Improvement District, its trustees, officers and employees from any and all claims, losses, harm, costs, liabilities, damages and expenses directly or indirectly from or related to the HET.
- Kearns Improvement District does not warrant or assume any liability for the design, manufacture, installation, or operation of any HET. Kearns Improvement District makes no warranty, express or implied, including, but not limited to, the warranty of merchantability and the warranty of fitness for a particular purpose about any HET purchased, installed, or used by homeowner.
- Deadline for this program is October 31, 2010. All toilets must be purchased and installation verified before the deadline date to receive the rebate.
