

Because we are experiencing below freezing temperatures, we have provided some helpful hints to prevent frozen water lines in homes below:

- Under most conditions when the temperature drops to 20 degrees or below, leave an inside tap dripping overnight.
- Open cupboard doors to allow heat to pipes near outside walls.
- If your meter lid is loose or not on your meter, call your water provider to have it fixed. Having the meter lid in place helps prevent accidents and acts as an insulator to help prevent frozen lines.
- Do not drive on the meter box or your water line areas. By driving over these areas, the frost is forced down and can lead to frozen lines.
- Insulate outdoor faucets and water lines where they enter the home, usually in the basement.
- If fire hydrants in your neighborhood are covered with snow, please be kind and remove the snow.
